How to Make a Water or Sewer Payment

The Town has a new payment tool to assist residents with their water and sewer payments. Residents have options on how to make payments:

- ⇒ **By Mail to:** 304 E Central Ave, Wiggins, CO 80654
- \Rightarrow Dropoff at:
 - * Town Hall at 304 E Central Ave, Wiggins
 - * After hours in black drop-box by the flag pole.

⇒ Online: townofwiggins.colorado.gov

- * Click on "Dollar Bill/Pay Online" and follow the prompts.
- * TO CREATE AN ACCOUNT FOR THE FIRST TIME Click the "Sign-In" link and "register" to view bills, payment history, set up payments.
- * TO DO A ONE TIME PAYMENT Click on the "Utility" button.
- * Account number & name will be required to create an account or for making one time payments online.

* DO NOT USE A DECIMAL POINT WHEN ENTERING ACCOUNT NUMBER.

Animal & ATV Tag Renewal Reminder-2022

Residents are reminded to renew all animal tags and ATV tags for the 2022 year. Animals must have an updated rabies vaccination from a veterinarian's office. Payment and certificate must be brought in to the Town Hall. Cost is \$5.

All ATV's and golf carts must be registered with the Wiggins Police Department before being driven on streets within the Town of Wiggins. Proof of insurance and payment may be brought in to the Town Hall to obtain a tag. Tags are \$20.

The Board of Trustees recently passed a resolution to create a citizen led Planning & Zoning Commission to make Land Use Application recommendations to the Board of Trustees. Applications to apply to be on the commission may be found and submitted online.

The Planning & Zoning Commission meets once a month on the second Tuesday of each month when there is an application to be reviewed. The Planning & Zoning Commissioner's primary responsibility is to make land use decisions that are consistent with the Town policies and plans formally adopted by the Board of Trustees. Al comments and recommendations are then passed on to the Board of Trustees for final approval.
